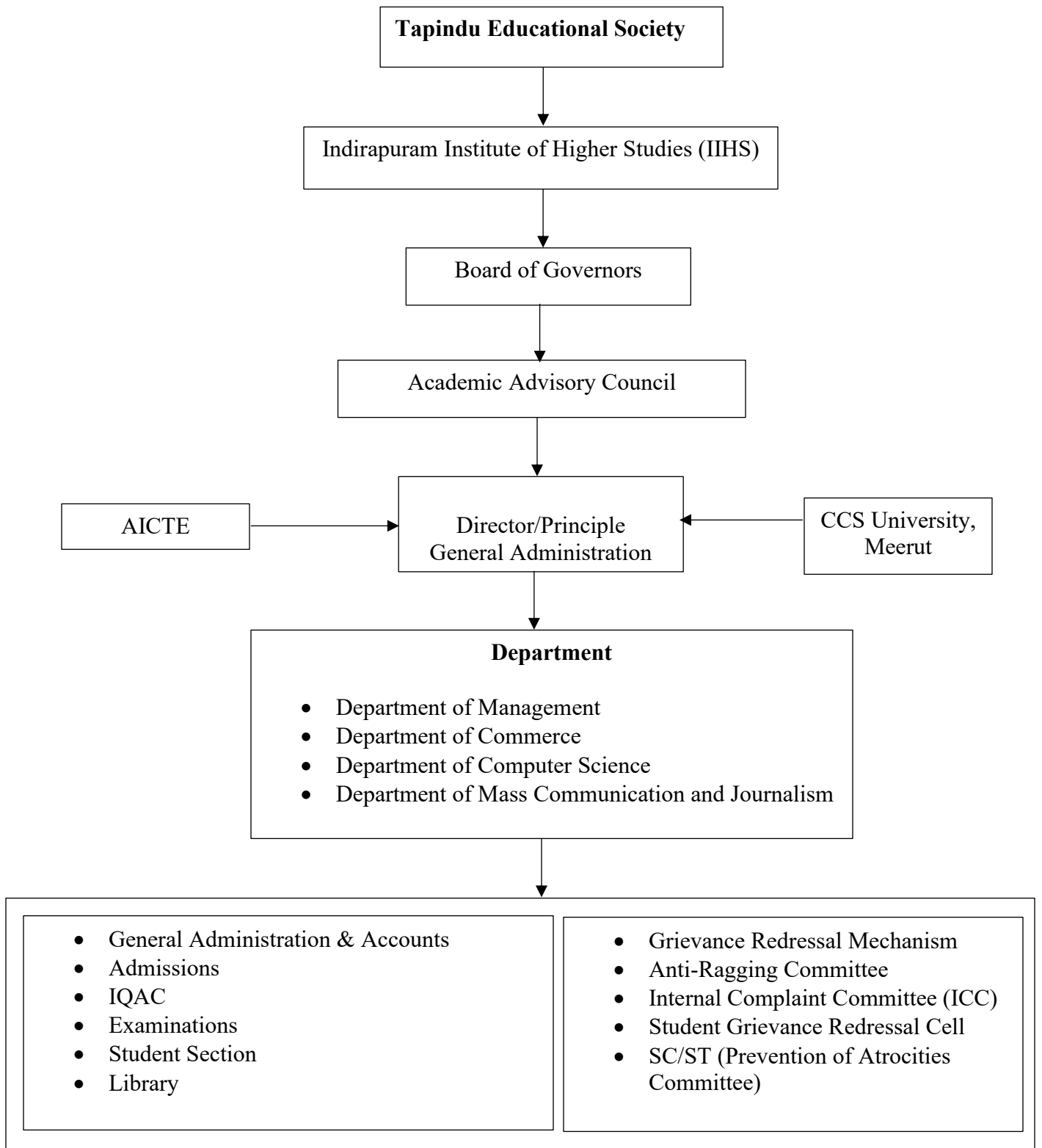

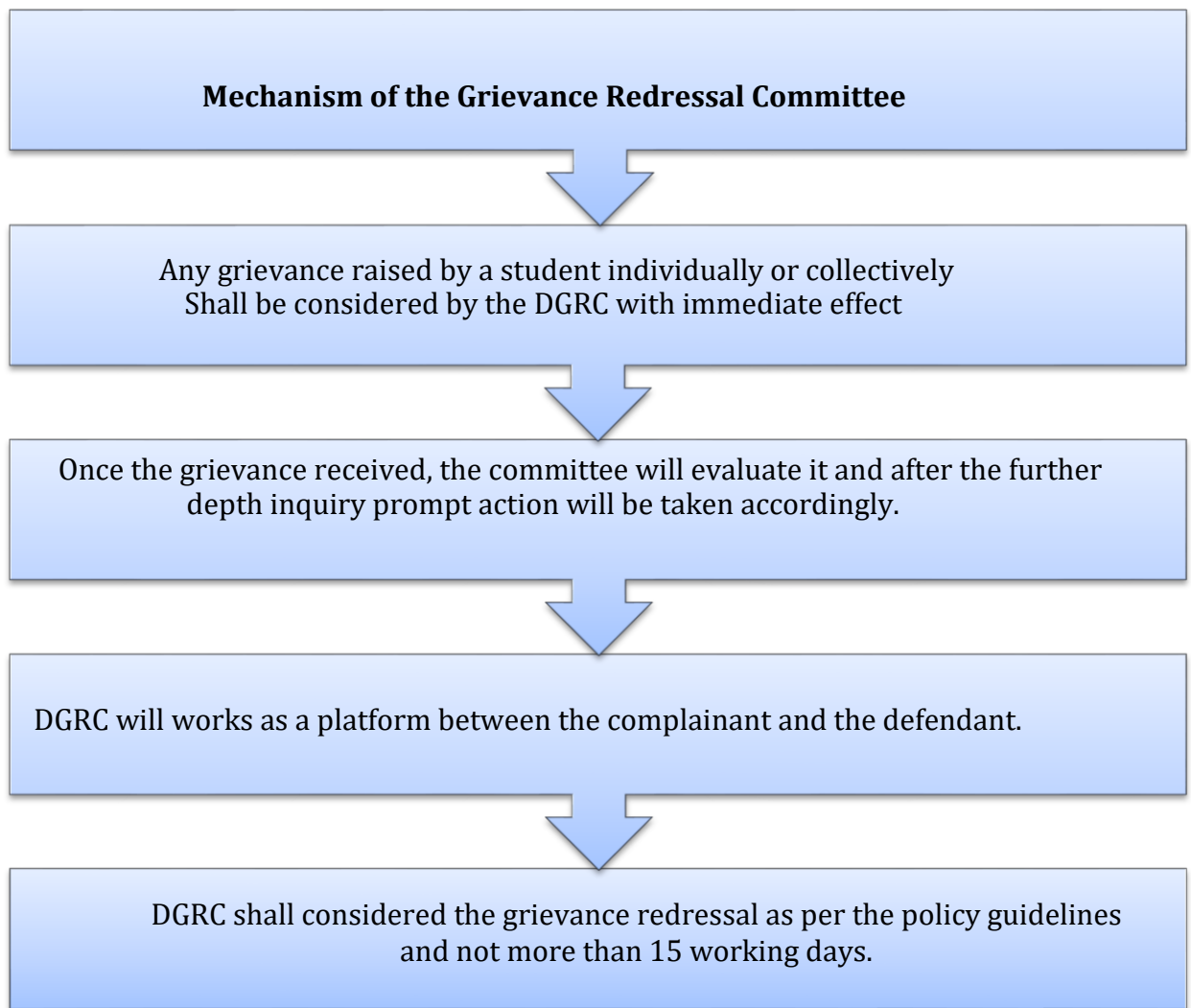

Key Policies and Objectives

- The establishment of this committee follows strict legal mandates to eliminate any form of physical or mental harassment.
- Zero Tolerance Policy: Any student found involved in ragging will face immediate disciplinary action, which may include suspension, expulsion, or the filing of a First Information Report (FIR) with the local police.
- Reporting Mechanism: Students can report grievances personally or via the telephone numbers listed above. The institute also maintains an "Online Caste Discrimination Prevention" and "Grievance Redressal" submission portal on its official website.
- Mandatory Undertakings: Every student and their parent/guardian must submit an anti-ragging affidavit/undertaking at the time of admission, confirming they are aware of the regulations and the consequences of violation.

ESTABLISHMENT OF GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE IN THE INSTITUTE

To settle the grievances of students related to academic and non-academic matters a Student Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC) has been established at the Institute.

Objectives:

- To provide opportunities for the redressal of the grievances of students already enrolled at the Institute, as well as those seeking admission to the Institute.
- To resolve the Grievances of students by developing an organizational framework.
- To offer students a seamless resource for addressing their grievances.
- To establish structured interactions with students to elicit information on their expectations regarding the grievances.
- To make the Institute student-friendly.

Procedure:

- Student shall make an application to the committee Chairperson regarding the grievances.
- The Chairman shall call the SGRC meeting to resolve the Grievances.
- SGRC while resolving the grievances, will follow the principles of natural justice.
- The SGRC shall send its report with recommendations, if any, to the concerned entity and a copy thereof to the aggrieved student, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the complaint.
- Any student who is dissatisfied with the ruling of the Student Grievance Redressal Committee may file an appeal to the Ombudsperson within 15 days from the date they receive the decision.
